The Code of Conduct becomes effective on 7th March 2022 and will continue till the announcement of results at AGM on 27th March 2022.

The candidates and their supporters should adhere to all moral standards during their campaign and show respect and courtesy to one another, conduct themselves with fair play and ethics.

- 1) No negative campaigning by the candidates is allowed
- 2) Campaigning can be done via social media such as SMS, WhatsApp, Email and Facebook.
- 3) Campaigning cannot be done on the official AMC WhatsApp groups

There are 52 official AMC groups based on the area. Campaigning cannot be done on these WhatsApp groups either by the candidate or their supporters. In case a candidate is found canvassing on these groups their name will be removed temporarily until the declaration of result and will be added back on 1st April 2019. The similar procedure will be followed for a member doing campaigning for a particular candidate in the AMC WhatsApp group. In this interim period should a member temporarily removed wish to send an official message to the other members in the group he can send it via the admin – AMC office.

AMC office will send out one email to all the members before the start of the elections notifying the candidates

- 4) At no cost should AMC finances be used for campaigning.
- 5) If any complaint is received against any candidate, then the decision regarding the candidature of the candidate is the prerogative of the Returning Officers and will be binding.

President's Report

After a prolonged virtual AGM held on 28th March 2021, I was installed as the President of AMC, a position of huge responsibility as well as honor, though virtually. Covid pandemic affected not only our lives personally but also professionally in a big way. However, with an open mind and a positive attitude I took over the responsibilities and started my work amidst the second wave of the pandemic, so that I could maintain the standards set by my predecessors and also complete the unfinished tasks. Being the 50th President, it was not an easy task to live up to as well as exceed the expectations of the past presidents, the entire managing committee with quite a few new members as well as the 13,000+ members of this esteemed Association.

The 2nd wave of Covid started raging in April and we immediately incorporated the activities of support by creating Covid Hospital and Covid support groups to our colleagues, their families and the people affected by this deadly pandemic. Public awareness was taken care of through videos on Covid appropriate behavior and protection by appropriate use of masks, prevention by vaccinations, double masking, etc. during the heights of pandemic. The second wave which affected more than 8.5 lakh people, claimed about one lakh lives peaked in May and June and continued till July. Even in October, the 2nd wave had not completely receded and hence we were still in partial lockdown for almost the entire year 2021. The horrendous times of the second wave with huge number of patients, nonavailability of beds across the country, with patients succumbing rapidly and that too at a young age, with lack of oxygen, with lack of medications for Covid treatment, was truly a nightmare. While we are grateful that we have survived this drastic 2nd wave, we really mourn the demise of our colleagues and of the people who lost their lives to Covid. During the times when there was severe deficiency of Oxygen across the city, AMC contacted many vendors for Oxygen concentrators, but unfortunately none were available at that time and delivery was proposed to be after 1 month, which didn't really serve the purpose.

The scare of the 3rd wave was anyways looming ahead and hanging like the sword over our heads. And the 3rd wave started in end of December, which again ruined our plans of AMCON which was scheduled on 30th January at Sahara Star. Thankfully, the 3rd wave did not cause as much devastation in terms of loss of lives and was of a much short duration.

With immense relief, our **Golden Jubilee celebrations** which could not be planned earlier shall be happening on **27th March 2022 at Sapphire Hall, Hotel Sahara Star, Mumbai**. The journey of 50 years will be showcased along with entertainment program as well as fashion show open to all members of AMC. All the members are cordially invited to join us in person for this once in a lifetime event with great happiness, pride and honor to be part of these celebrations.

Violence in healthcare have been a major threat to the medical professionals. AMC has been working on this front for many years and in first week of April 2021, AMC became the intervenor in the Criminal PIL 2332/2020 filed by Dr. Rajeev Joshi for The Maharashtra Medicare Service Persons And Medicare Service Institutions (Prevention Of Violence And Damage Or Loss To Property) Act, 2010. Maharashtra Act No. XI of 2010.

Several meetings with our Medicolegal cell, Dr. Sudhir Naik, Dr. Lalit Kapoor, the lawyers and the State level Committee for amendments were held throughout the year for taking this cause forward. The matter was listed for hearing in High Court multiple times (more than 30 times) during the year since April onwards. Details of all medicolegal cell activities are provided in separate report by Chairman of medicolegal cell Dr. Sudhir Naik.

Another major challenge which the medical professionals especially the nursing home owners have been facing surfaced again with Fire compliance of Nursing homes issues. AMC not only organized educative program but also opened direct communication with the Chief Fire officer with whom multiple meetings and emails communications have been done throughout the year following which we were able to directly report any of the complaint received from the members. With the good offices of Dr. Suresh Rao Chairman and Dr. Niranjana Agarwal, Immediate Past Chairman of Noah cell, Mr. Rajesh Shinde willingly participated in one to one dialogue with the members and is resolving their matters satisfactorily from any zone of Mumbai. Multiple

joint meetings were held with the Health Department of MCGM and the Fire Department so that the myriad issues of the members can be appropriately tackled.

AMC along with FEQH (Forum for Enhancement of Quality in Healthcare) designed and organized an **innovative competition** amongst nursing homes in the areas of Autoclave Management, OT Management and Innovative practices. The presentations were scrutinized by a committee of doctors and allied healthcare professionals. The winners of the competition are as per the categories as follows: A. Autoclave Management – 1st Prize Women Hospital, 2nd Prize Bayview clinic. B. OT Management: Kamdar Nursing Home. C. Innovation management: 1st prize Shroff eye hospital, 2nd prize Women Hospital.

Sunil Pal a stand-up comedian made false and derogatory remarks towards doctors and medical community and posted it on social media in April 2021. He painted the medical community as rogues indulging in malpractice & organ trafficking. Since these frivolous allegations were capable of creating panic amongst the society and disrupting the tireless efforts of the medical professionals in this pandemic, a FIR was lodged in Andheri police station against him CR no. 490/2021 U sec 505(2), 500 IPC r/w sec 3 Maharashtra Medicare Service persons and Medicare Institutions Act 2010. Sunil Pal applied for anticipatory bail for which multiple hearings happened in the sessions court in Dindoshi with Advocate Robin representing in the court and remote support provided by Adv Sunil Khatri. Letter to Maharashtra Medical Council President Dr. Shivkumar Utture was also sent for judicious action to be taken by the Council. Multiple visits to the police station as well as Sessions court were done by me for lodging the FIR and for the court hearing.

May 2021 onwards, the Tribunal constituted by Dr. Niranjana Agarwal (Head), Dr. Sabh Singh Khambay, Dr. Shrikant Badwe came into action due to complaints from the contestants during the elections of 2021-22. The Tribunal required frequent coordination and support of the office which was handled in spite of the raging pandemic so that the election related complaints could be efficiently handled. The Tribunal appointed Satrix for third audit of the election process, the report of which arrived on 10th November, following which it was presented in Managing Committee meeting on 28th November. The MC members mandated to hold a special AGM for the election related matters which came up during the discussion of this managing committee meeting, following which special AGM was held on 23rd January 2022, during which new election officers on an ad-hoc basis were appointed for this year's elections of 2022-23.

With a vision and mission of improving the quality of life of medical professionals and their families and directly as well as indirectly through them of the patients, their families through counselling, education, support and advocacy many activities were carried out throughout the year.

In these tough times, due to the Covid pandemic, no on-site program could be held. However, without losing our grit, we set on our goals and began with a series of programs. 3 main topics were chosen for series such as Nari Shakti, Covid, Financial freedom. Nari shakti began with the purpose of empowering, enabling and entrusting the women professionals as well as the women of this country. 3 programs were held to achieve our goal under the banner of Nari Shakti where health, nutrition, diet, various exercise routines, and organ specific knowledge and tips were imparted, the videos of which are available on the you-tube channel of AMC. The 2nd topic for the series was Covid 19 wherein 3 programs were done, Covid Update 1.0, Corona se Mukabala, Covid Update 2.0. The 3rd topic for the series was to improve the Financial health of the medical professionals through series of programs on Finance through FINCON – Part 1, Part 2, Part 3 all-encompassing different aspects. Online course in training the members to read their own financial statements and to increase profitability in their practices was undertaken for the first time in the history of AMC, which was carried out over 3 hours online training in 6 sessions. Several other online programs were held, the details of which are provided in the report by the very active, enthusiastic and committed Program Committee Chairman Dr. Vikrant Desai.

For the very first time in AMC, Online courses have been started and many more are yet to come. The Online courses done are with the following topics: Structured Virtual Course on Basic Legal Issues in Medical Practice, Iyengar Yoga, Masterclass in Financial Literacy and strategic planning, Digital Health Mission and Hands on training in Cloud Technologies.

I strongly believe that for the external or exterior to be strong, we have to strengthen our internal systems in such a way that the external forces can never shake up or disrupt our existence.

With this view in mind, the first and foremost task from April onwards was to resolve the labour matters of the office as per the latest Labour laws. Within few days of my installation, some urgent Labour matters regarding one of the staff, who suddenly resigned, came up which took considerable time and effort to resolve, but it did with the most valuable guidance of Dr. Lalit Kapoor and support of entire Managing Committee. A labour consultant was identified and appointed to look into all the labour related matters and also to update us from time to time regarding the latest guidelines which AMC was supposed to follow. Great effort and time was spent on understanding the situations and thence prepare documents accordingly. The appointment letters to all staff, their salary structures, the detailed employee handbook for guiding them through the requirements of AMC were structured and implemented for the first time in the history of AMC. The existing staff were also reassigned and new office manager has been appointed for smooth functioning of the office.

The **Local Complaints Committee** was also set up based on the Vishakha guidelines to address and resolve any issue/complaint of sexual harassment at workplace. This is a redressal body under the Prevention of Sexual Harassment of Women at workplace Act, 2013. The tenure of the Committee is from 1st April 2021 till 31st March 2023. The Composition of the committee is as follows: Chairperson: Dr. Sujata Rao (President), Members: Dr. Veena Pandit (Secretary) (M), Ms. Pramila Bambarkar (Committee member), Mr. Mugatrao Pawar (Committee member) and External member: Adv. Ms. Anupama Talekar (Committee Member).

Another major benefit provided to the full-time staff was individual Health and Accident (Mediclaime) Policy to them, again for the first time in the history of AMC with the kind intervention and support of Dr. Suhas Kate Chairman of H&A cell and Dr. Suresh Rao, Advisor of H&A cell.

Concurrently, our new committee members were brought together and an Orientation session was organized which was conducted by Dr. Mukesh Gupta. A complete set of orientation kit with detailed information of the cells as well as application forms for several schemes of AMC were provided to the entire Managing Committee members.

Synchronously, understanding the need to encompass the massive growth of the association and the need to safeguard the interests of the members, Advocate Vicky Shah was appointed to structure an individualized IT policy for AMC and also to implement it. This activity has also been the first attempt in the history of AMC and a very productive exercise too, as we could update ourselves with the current IT laws. All agreements with the several key players of the IT team such as Advocate Vicky Shah, Mr. Bhavesh Thakkar from Chowgule Mediconsults were put in place, new servers were purchased, and diligent administration for smooth operations were done.

Website is the face of the Association and also an essential tool for association to establish their credibility and build trust with members. Optimum functioning of the website has always been important and for this lots of efforts were put in by our earlier as well as current website editors, Dr. Aparna Govil Bhaskar & Dr. Nitin Bhatnagar. Personally too humungous amount of effort was put in coordinating between 2 vendors for website till as late as October 2021.

Apart from the routine website organisation and upliftment new features were added in the website. Most importantly, Online membership application and approvals have been started for the first time in AMC. The process of new membership applications online along with submission of completed form and payment have been done as well as approval of membership have been automated and done online. This feature has now given the new members an advantage to get the process of membership completed in the shortest duration of time, as early as within one hour. The applications as well as approvals can be done from anywhere and anytime and is now not dependant on physically being present in the office for the approvals of membership applications.

Simultaneously, the website, mobile app and software had to be brought in sync and was done so after the website work was completed. During implementation of IT policy, as recommended by the Cyber lawyer, our web based platform was shifted from www.amcmumbai.com to www.amcmumbai.org being a charitable organization. So the entire platform was migrated. We also discussed and switched from Google platform for our domain emails to Zoho platform. All email ids were configured with coordination of each user and migrated all the emails in the inbox to the new email ids with the prompt and constant support of Dr. Rajesh

Bijlani, our committee member. We had 20 existing email ids on google platform, and we added another 24 email ids and also provided domain email ids to the agents who have been earlier collecting all information and members' data on their personal email ids. Hope all the members are communicating with their respective agents on the domain email ids provided to them. In case if you have not been informed by the agent, do take their AMC domain ids and communicate on that only. The members were informed from time to time about the changes, however, to capture any misdirected emails from anyone, a separate email id support@amcmumbai.org was created so that there is no loss of any email which had been sent to any email of AMC on the previous amcmumbai.com domain email ids. This mechanism allowed us to seamlessly perform all the functions of the association.

The mobile app which had become completely dysfunctional due to change in website structure in 2018, and which could not be rectified due to non-compliance of two different vendors was also revived with huge amount of efforts at my end to get the vendors on the same platform and also to work in sync. Currently the mobile app is in complete sync with the website and the database and provides a complete and updated information at all times.

New features have also been added in the mobile app, in which is the **SOS** message can be triggered as **Orange alert** or **Red alert** and the message is immediately sent to all the members in the same pin code as well as to Chairman of Medicolegal cell, President and Secretary. The details of the sender as well as the mobile number are mentioned in the message which makes it very convenient for anyone receiving the message to contact the member in trouble. Another new feature is ability to edit your own data in case if there is any change in location, email id or phone number which once changed, automatically gets updated in the database. The launch of the SOS function of mobile app was done on 12th December 2021 during MLCON.

A very exciting feature of mobile app is the "Edit profile" functionality in the mobile app. A member after logging in can go to **Members section** which will open the dashboard. On the dashboard, click on My Profile to view your profile as well as edit and update the latest information which will automatically be updated in the database and thus will not require multiple calls/messages or email to either office staff or to any office bearer.

The **new office premises** at 302, Summit Business Park, Andheri (E) which were purchased in 2020 March and officially acquired in 2020 August also needed to be renovated and utilized. Dr. Niranjana Agarwal, as in-charge of the renovation project, finalized the interior designer and the work started in August 2021. Under supervision and guidance of Dr. Niranjana Agarwal, Dr. Kishore Adyanthaya and other members of the Trust Board, the work progressed at a rapid rate. Continuous monitoring of the renovation work with troubleshooting at multiple levels and coordination with several other teams such as CCTV, Biometric, new phone lines, new internet connection, computer and IT related equipment, etc. with the Trust Board was undertaken personally by me and finally the new premises were ready post-Diwali. An inaugural Pooja or Grahpravesh was done on the auspicious day of 9th November 2021 and the final shifting was done on 27th November 2021. A formal inauguration of the premises was done on 28th November 2021 by Dr. Lalit Kapoor (President FAMCI), myself (President AMC), Dr. Kishore Adyanthaya (Managing Trustee) and Dr. Niranjana Agarwal (IPM Trustee), followed by the 1st Managing Committee meeting in our new office on the same day.

The social media handles of AMC were also revived, new YouTube channel created and an expert was appointed to handle the social media platforms. Numerous videos were created to raise awareness about the association as well as to educate the public through our social media platforms such as YouTube channel: <https://www.youtube.com/c/AMCCMEProgram>,

Most of the CME's were also streamed live on Social media platforms with engagement of the medical community on these handles.

Throughout the year 6 Managing committee meetings, 1 special AGM, and almost 20 Office bearers meetings were held. Within the managing committee, Zonal committees, academic committee, IT committee, program committee, website committee and editorial committee multiple meetings were held to carry forward the work

of the Association in each respective area. Zonal task force groups were created for prompt handling of all matters related to violence against any of our members. Affiliation guidelines were also finalised in which several criteria were laid down for other associations or individual organisations to affiliate with AMC. Meetings was also done with Presidents, secretary and other office bearers of MARD (Maharashtra Association of Resident Doctors) to look into the issues faced by them particularly during the Covid period. The resident doctors really appreciated our efforts and also thanked the association for providing them health policies with Covid cover. Constant round the clock support was provided to all members whoever communicated via phone call, WhatsApp message, email or message through other member and the best possible was done to resolve their queries or difficulties.

Several donations were made by AMC in this year such as:

1. 5000 Venus N95 masks for Covid care in April 2021 to ACTREC (Advanced Centre for Treatment, Research and Education in Cancer), coordinated by Dr. Sudhir Naik.
2. Distribution of 8000 masks to the general public at Andheri station on Doctor's Day, 1st July 2021, provided through Dr. Suhas Shah.
3. Iyengar Yoga Trust for conducting yoga courses for the members of the Association and for the general public.
4. Donation of Rs. 50,000 towards "Save the girl child and Educate the Girl child project" education fund to Medscape India, coordinated through Dr. Sunita Dube.
5. Donation of more than 200 blankets in the Adivasi population of Jawahar & Mukhada Maharashtra, coordinated through Dr. Rajendra Chavan.

Several other social service projects were undertaken for the benefit of the society, under the able Chairmanship of Dr. Ajit Desai, the detail of which is attached in the relevant section of the annual report.

A major undertaking of AMC was to promote and propagate the Basic Life Support courses for the general public which AMC has been doing for many years off and on. The course was conducted for the staff of AMC as well as the entire Summit Business Park members in our new AMC office by the President Dr. Yogen Bhatt and Secretary Dr. Shilpa Tiwaskar from the Indian Society of Anaesthesiologist and Indian Resuscitation Council. The modules were video recorded with participation and hands-on training of all the staff. The videos were also circulated through our Youtube channel to the general public.

Student membership has been approved in previous AGM of 2018 during the Presidency of Dr. Smita Sharma. Taking the baton forward from there and with the active support and intervention of Dr. Smita Sharma, student membership has been implemented this year and launched on 17th February 2022 wherein facilities for online membership on website as well as mobile app have been provided.

Adopting the technological advances, Online application and approval portal for Affiliate units of AMC Mangalore, Bangalore, Pune, Nashik, Sindhudurg, Goa, Ratnagiri are ongoing with permission and approval of office-bearers of FAMCI following creation and implementation of a successful similar online application and approval model for AMC Mumbai.

Following nomination of Association of Medical Consultants for the 7th Flagship "The Business Leadership Conclave and Awards", I am proud to announce that AMC won the **Leader in Healthcare Award** during the event of International Women Leaders Forum in November 2021.

A Financial committee has also been set up this year to look into the investment options for the Association. This committee comprises of President, Secretary, Managing Trustee, President-Elect, 2 trustees, Dr. Niranjan Agarwal and Dr. Ajit Desai. Preliminary meeting concluded successfully recently with action points for the near future.

The new office is also acquiring state of the art **Video-conferencing system**, the negotiations and purchase order of which has already been put in place and the entire system shall be installed within a week's time.

AMC has also been actively engaging with the authorities at the state as well as Central level for the several healthcare related issues including Violence in Healthcare.

The Grasp, our official magazine, has been given a new look with team work and carrying forward of new ideas and thoughts which were envisioned way back in January 2021 when I first saw the flip-book format of New India Samachar and amazingly contemplated by our Grasp Editor too. In spite of huge amount of assignments going on concurrently, the Grasp was given more than enough attention this year by me on all fronts of designing, formatting, authors of articles, etc. with the constant help of our new editor Dr. Alok Modi. With his ideas, the endeavor to create and publish unique theme based issues of the magazine (which could not be managed this year due to multiple factors) shall materialize in the near future and provide valuable insights to the readers.

Several news articles were published regarding Masks, Myths and Facts about Vaccination, Pediatric Covid and its implications, PIL done by AMC and about the FIR against Mr. Sunil Pal.

As soon as we felt Covid pandemic has ended, with the active coordination of Dr. Bipin Pandit, we planned for our very interesting and famous Conference Tour. Being the golden Jubilee year, 2 Conference tours were planned this year between February-March 2022. However, due to the third wave in January 2022, the dates of the tours had to be rescheduled and finalized from end of March till end of April/May. The 2 beautiful and exotic locations of our conference tours are **Wonders of Northeast of India** and **Turkish Delight**. The Wonders of North east is for 11 nights/12 days and is covering Meghalaya – Shillong, Mawlynnong, Dawki, Cherrapunjee, Arunachal Pradesh – Tawang, Dirang, Bhalukpong/Bomdilla and Assam – Kaziranga, Guwahati, Tezpur. The Turkish Delight Tour is for 9days and covers Cappadocia, Izmir, Pammukale, Antalya, Istanbul. Do join any of these tours and have a pleasurable experience as well as enchanting memories for the future.

January 2022 onwards the MMC Registration renewals were also set in motion. Chairperson of MMC interaction cell of AMC, Dr. Sujata Rao very proactively and promptly coordinated with the members for a smooth process of online renewals through our office. Individualised support was provided to any member even when they visited our office with their challenges.

On the academic front, AMC has initiated “**Clinical study**” with Iyengar Yogashraya on the topic of “**Effect of Iyengar Yoga practice on the health of Medical Professionals**”. This study is supported by Department of Science and Technology, Government of India and is conducted by Iyengar Yogashraya free of cost to the participants over a period of 3 months. A control group is yet to be formed, so members are encouraged to participate in this genuine and authentic study which will be hugely beneficial to the advancement of this aspect of our vital force.

I take this opportunity to thank the entire Team AMC 2021-22 and am sincerely grateful to the entire office bearers and committee members (even if I have not mentioned their name in the report), am truly indebted to the seniors, Chairpersons of cells, Trustees who have shown the guiding light at every turn. Many thanks to all the members of AMC who entrusted me to lead I wish the incoming President Dr. Nilima Vaidya Bhamare and her future team as well as all future Presidents which will be bearing the torch of the bright future of AMC.

The year started for the new Team 2021 – 2022, on 28th March 2021. The threat of the pandemic continued, but could not succeed in keeping our determination down. Under the dynamic leadership of our President Prof. Sushmita Bhatnagar, we have had an extremely productive and rewarding term - replete with many firsts, advances and developments at organizational level. Let this go on record that I witnessed a leader who was willing to go all out for improving the existing system with respect to a variety of issues such as work ethics, cost-cutting, staff discipline and data security. Every house requires decluttering once in a while; and Madam President did so, even at the cost of creating unease amongst some of its residents.

Some salient activities and events of the year

The AMC has 8 Cells and 4 Committees, namely, Medico-legal Cell, H&A Cell, CBS Cell, NOAH Cell, Social Service Cell, Affiliate Cell, Media & Communication Cell, MMC Interaction Cell, Program Committee, IT Committee, Website Editorial Committee and Grasp Editorial Committee. The 'meet and greet' program was conducted on 10th April, 2021 especially for the new MC members - an orientation meeting about the AMC and its activities and to help them know each other better. The Chairman of Media & Communication Cell, Dr. Mukesh Gupta chaired and conducted this meeting, which was appreciated by all.

"Nari Shakti" Season 1 – Webinar, for the women by the women was held on 25th April 2021, in association with Finnovate.

AMC Webinar COVID UPDATE 1.0 was held on 2nd May 2021. It was a very well appreciated CME, with one credit hour granted by MMC.

One 23rd May 2021, One-stop solution - Fire in hospital - was the next Webinar, and was granted one credit hour by MMC.

The Internal Complaints Committee was formed with trustee Dr. Sujata Rao as Chairperson and other internal and external members.

Labour Consultant was appointed and various scopes of duties were assigned to her. She started working on Staff Muster, appointment letters, job profiles, etc.

The AMC Website urgently required to be updated, upraised and made more user friendly. Taking the initiative, Dr. Aparna Govil Bhasker, Website Editor did an exemplary work.

Around 1000 masks were donated to Tata Memorial Centre, Kharghar with help of NOAH Cell. This was lauded by Mr. S. H. Jafri, Sr. Admin Officer.

"Corona se muqabala", a Community Program of AMC, was held on 6th June 2021 as a webinar, relayed on YouTube Live and was attended by doctors and general public.

International Yoga Day was celebrated in association with the Iyengar Yogashraya, on 20th June 2021.

The process of renovation of the new office began in June 2021.

On the occasion of Doctors' Day 2021, a webinar was organized. Tributes were paid to COVID warriors by inviting the immediate family members of the deceased AMC Members. This was followed by a live, interactive program by world famous Mentalist, Mr. Nicholi Frederich from Germany.

Syncom Financial Freedom Series program was held online on 15th August 2021 and was well attended and appreciated.

Dr. Nitin Bhatnagar was appointed as Website Editor on Adhoc basis from November 2021 after Dr. Aparna Govil Bhasker resigned from the post in October. AMC Website saw many more changes for the better – new domain, hosting platforms, etc.

FINCON 2 was held virtually on 14th November 2021, in association with Finnovate. Mr. Nilesh Shah, Managing Director of Kotak Mahindra AMC, was the guest of honour and the Keynote speaker. Sanchay Plus - guaranteed return plan by HDFC - was released by the President Madam.

Formal inauguration of the new office was performed and 4th Managing Committee Meeting for 2021-2022 was held at the new AMC office, 302, Summit Business Park, W. E. Highway, Andheri (East), Mumbai on Sunday, 28th November 2021.

IT Policy has been adopted by AMC keeping in mind the laws applicable to us as well as for the security of our IT systems, our Association and its members. The process started in April/May and completed in November 2021.

Dr. Sujata Rao : There was a message floated across the WA group asking for nominations for chairpersons . So a limiting date needs to be given . So MCM has selected from those applications . So now new names cannot be invited

Dr. Deepak Baid : whenever we suggest names we need members to ratify the same .

Dr. Sujata Rao : We need to say that the MCM has sifted thru all applications and now propose the following names for ratification . Otherwise the entire process of application & selection is a waste.

Dr. Ketan Parikh : When these applications were invited , who voted ?

Dr. Sujata Rao : this adv. was sent to all AMC members . This was received & discussed in the MCM & a voice vote was taken for a poll .

Dr. Ketan Parikh : The word ratification needs to be changed

Dr. Lalit Kapoor : then we say that we are informing

Dr. Ketan Parikh : then it needs to be ammended in the constitution

A lot of people started talking all of a sudden .

Dr. Deepak Baid : Request all members to stick to the agenda .

Dr. Nilima Vaidya-Bhamare : The entire idea of circulating that message was to not to miss out on a single member to miss out on the opportunity to give his or her name for lack of information regarding vacancy . A good year this time . Claim ratio is under 80 so far inspite of COVID . 5766 members were offered 7 lakhs additional policy cost of which was bourne by H&A Cell from 1st June 2020 to 31st May 2021

Medicolegal cell

Dr. Sudhir Naik :

PI negotiated a 25 % discount as compared to last 2 yrs . Last yr cheques could not be deposited due to COVID & cheques remained with agents . But all the issues were able to be solved except 1/2 where proof could not be given , so retro active date could not be made but the cell was trying it's level best to restore the retro active date .

This yr 6900/7000 cheques have already been collected . Advance payment of 3.5 cr has been made to oriental which will be adjusted on 31 st March . Exponential increase in not only the number of cases but also in remuneration . 11 cases were settled out of court which saved a decent amount of money in those indefensible cases . We request members to increase the indemnity cover as verdict comes years later . A minimum of 1 cr for physicians & 1.5 cr for surgeons has been recommended . Errors & omissions policy also 20% discount in premiums was given .

National forum is asking for deposit of entire decretal amount before admitting cases . Our insurance policy however pays it upfront .

Dr. Sudhir Naik : It was proposed that ... Anyone wishing to be member of AMC MC , then he has to be a member of at least 2 of the 3 schemes of AMC . A constitutional ammendment needed for the same . The in coming President can take it up .

Dr. Manoj : no one can make it compulsory . It is the compulsion which is not right

Agenda 11) any other matter with permission of chair ... Dr. Sujata Rao requested this to be taken after declaration of results & installation of new committee

Dr. Deepak Baid requested the election officers to take over .

Dr. Mukesh Gupta :

Informed the house that there was an episode where there was a change of polling form order . To verify whether this was accidental or wilfull , after several rounds of meetings with election officers it was decided to do a complete research into the incident . Darshan Gesota was asked to brief . He said that one of his employees had accidentally switched off the table , which was repopulated immediately . Darshan had evaluated the situation after checking his backend office & grilling his personelle and said that it was accidental . This was however not taken at face value by the election officers . It was decided to appoint two auditors , one by Darshan & one by AMC . One auditor was chosen randomly from the government certified list so that no external influence of bias was applied in choosing the auditors . The second auditor was chosen after consultation with the crime branch who get their forensic audits done from him . All 3 EOs unanimously decided on these two finally for complete elimination of bias & maintain neutrality for finding out if there was foul play of any sorts which can affect the outcome of the elections . We are awaiting the written final report as auditors did not want to give an interim report as they wanted authenticity & finality in the report . So it was decided to wait . If foul play was detected , or if the report suggested that if that person who made the mistake has done so wilfully or under anyone's influence then the report shall not be published & it will be brought back to the MCM / AGM whichever is constitutionally acceptable . However if it is proven that it just an error as it is being claimed by the agency , then we shall not waste anyone's time & energy . He suggested declaration of names of unoppsed candidates .

One hrs time was asked for & further AGM to be conducted . He assured that once they have a written confirmed report that there was no foul play , only then will they key in to find out & declare the election results otherwise we will wait

Dr. Vipin Checker :

As election officer I am in sync with what Dr. Mukesh Gupta has stated . A recorded zoom meeting took place when the fiasco in the election took place . Darshan from Nityam was there on the zoom call & he categorically

stated that on a recorded call that the board had crashed and there was truncation of data. He also said that Mr Yatin Shah who was there , was having all rights , so there was a possibility that the votes could be tampered with or votes be deleted . Darshan was repeatedly asked why AMC data base was kept open , the reply given was not found satisfactory to me personally . AGM was informed that a legal notice was received from one candidate for which AMC will have to appoint a lawyer to respond to it . If AMC lawyer is able to give a reply to this notice only then shall I punch in the last key subject to the reports by internal auditor by Nityam & external Auditor by AMC

He congratulated the unopposed elected candidates but said that installation shall not be complete till whole team is elected . AGM & candidates need to be informed as to what stand they can take regarding the crash that occurred in the software .

Also he left it to the AGM to decide if a re election needs to be held or additional auditors need to be appointed or to go ahead with report of current auditor in view of the legal notice received to avoid a legal battle later

Dr. Mukesh Gupta : he was not aware of legal notice . Dr. Smita Sharma was also not aware . She was reaching physically to AMC office . He requested Dr. Vipin Checker to share the contents of the legal notice with the EOs or AGM

If we do get a written report from the hired auditors & if the AGM permits us , then we should not shy away from legal notice & put the organization at stake .

Dr. Deepak Baid : look into the legal notice to protect the reputation of the Association

Dr. Sudhir Naik :

1)Notice has to be shared immediately with the other 2 ROs

2)We have to go strictly by letter & spirit of the constitution . ROs have the right to receive the complaints about any malpractices . RO need to deliberate over the notice . We have to wait for the written reports of the auditors . If there is even an iota of doubt , then we need to file a case in the cyber crime cell as the matter is serious . However if there is no doubt raised , then even if we have received a legal notice which aims at derailing the entire election process ,is uncalled for we trust the description of ROs , ROs need to go thru the entire process of the audit . If the audit is not able clear , then withhold the election results . Whatever has been announced is announced . The previous members where election results are not announced can continue for a few more days till everything is sorted out .

My suggestion : even if both audits give a decision that it was an innocent mistake , after results are announced , a third audit needs to be conducted to reconfirm the same .

Dr. Vipin Checker: the notice has been sent to all EOs on email .

Dr. Narendra Dedhia : why was the format changed ? Has the format been changed to original one?

r. Mukesh Gupta : the polling pattern was sent to the EOs for approval . The restored version was one version before the final version (which was changed as per constitutional order) That was the error . His information came from President himself who came to know about it the night before . The EOs were updated after President confirmed with Nityam & EOs were informed at 8 in the evening . Meeting was finally taken with all 3 EOs & MT & a few trustees . As polling officer my main concern is to find if there was a malafied intention to sabotage the process of election or it was an inadvertent mistake who accidentally did this for which the credible auditors have been appointed

Dr. Deepak Baid : I shall tell you the chronology of events .

I was informed by one of the candidates that one of his family members had difficulty in voting . So when he checked the ballot paper , it was different from the ballot paper on which he had voted . He approached me n i asked him if he was sure that the order was changed . No one was very sure as you cannot compare unless u have the previous & current ballot paper together to compare . Hence Nityam was contacted to confirm if the ballot paper was changed . Natyam responded at 10.30 am next morning saying that he was out of mumbai & would check asap . He called up again on his way back and called at around 2 pm saying that there seems to have been a change in the ballot paper . Only after confirming this I informed the EOs . A zoom meeting was arranged for at 7.30 by Dr. Smita Sharma .

Dr. Smita Sharma : we were informed after 12/20 hrs after u came to know .

Ur holding back information from EOs is an unconstitutional act .

Dr. Sudhir Naik : we had a meeting of MC this morning . Let us wait for the report to come . Time frames will be needed only if some hanky panky has occurred . Go ahead with installation of next committee .
Dr. Narendra Dedhia : why Yatin has not informed of the glitch occurred either to Nityam or to EOs
Dr. Ketan Parikh : this is a serious matter . My experience with darshan during IAP election : Once the election starts , nothing in the software can be interfered with till end of election . Those were Darshans own words . A dry run is conducted & then software is locked till end of election . I am surprised that , a person could interfere with the process . This is a serious event & has to be thoroughly investigated & Nityam needs to be told that their system is flawed .

Dr. Mukesh Gupta : Multiple penetration tests are being done

- 1) to see if any outside hack is possible in the system
- 2) how many tables have been affected
- 3) the whole log has been evaluated from the time span that this episode has happened & it was found out that only 5 people had voted & it was validated as it was as per the vote paper
- 4) all the data was evaluated before & after the incident to see if there was any gross change in the trend
- 5) it was checked if a new command or new log or new algorithm was inserted was evaluated . They refused to give an interim report & said that only final report shall be given in written form . Request was made to AGM to trust the process . No candidate should be wrongly portrayed of losing the election unless there was definite evidence of tampering . Even if 1% chance is there we will approach the criminal justice system . Hence we had approached the crime branch & then chose the auditor who can follow the police perspective as well .

We have gone through a grind of 72 hrs to authenticate the safe guards

Dr. Ketan Parikh : we are not talking of a snag . We are talking of interference . what is truncation of data?

Dr. Vipin Checker: Data was being handled by Yatin . I have not understood why was AMC database open on his laptop . No satisfactory answer yet available in 48 hrs . Answer given was Yatin was working on another project & by mistake he closed our data , when he realised his mistake , he reopened . When he reopened the site had crashed so he had to reload the ballot paper , where he picked up an old ballot paper , hence last 2/3 names were not there .

Dr. Ketan Parikh : why the EOs were not informed by Nityam ?

Dr. Abhay Dalvi : It is very important to know whether the vendor is at fault or no . How did the data base get opened because data base is closed by EOs by generating a particular password . once the election starts not a single person can interfere including the election manager .once the election is over , another password is generated by the EOs and then only the results are generated . So i have few questions for the EOs

- 1) One person said that the glitch was for minutes , another person said hours
- 2) What do you mean when you say it is opened database . How does one open the data base without the 3 election officers putting in the password
- 3) whatever is the result who will hold office in the interim period just in case need be . A lot of people are holding office & contesting elections . Do they continue or they are replaced ? It is impossible to open the data base just individually by some yatin . So i want to know what exactly was the glitch , what was the crash , for how many hrs ? They cannot start the election again unless the 3 EOs put in their password .

Dr. Vipin Checker: no justifiable answer was given by Nityam in a recorded meeting as to how AMC database was open .

Dr. Mukesh Gupta : it was not the data base which was open . It was the table . The table got truncated . Which means that the order of visibility of candidate on ballot paper changed . He rectified it . When we are talking about the data we are not talking about the vote bank or AMC data . We are talking about the data of that table . This table is different from the table of vote . That is a separate table . From the table link goes to another table & that table is where the votes to individual candidates is going and that table is locked & not open even now . No one can see how the vote is going . Nityam was also unable to answer as to why their employee had opened the table. Nityam has agreed to foot the bill of the expenses incurred for the audit . If foul play is detected criminal action shall be instituted . The two auditors have verbally confirmed that there was no change in the algorithm or data process . But unless we get the written results we shall not announce the results. Yatin has confessed to his mistake .

Dr. Sujata Rao : This has been a gross error undoubtedly . All 3 EOs have acted swiftly to find the culprit in a manner which can be defended . The AGM appoints the RO so should also indemnify the ROs .

Dr. Rajesh Bijlani : Databases are not easy to hack . If at all someone has interfered , it will be well logged . The logs will explicitly tell the auditors if any tampering was done . The intentions whether malicious or otherwise can be tackled later

Dr. Rajeev Agarwal : we should proceed with installation of unopposed elected members .

Dr. Anand Parihar : EOs have done a good job .

We are going to install only 1/3rd committee . Once the audit report comes , we can install the whole committee after results .

Dr. Niranjan Agarwal : we can install the unopposed candidates .

Dr. Oza , Dr. Dalvi , Dr. Bipin , Dr. Sudhir Naik , Dr. Kate had no objections

Dr. Nilima Vaidya-Bhamare: When the glitch occurred , were the other candidates informed ? It's the right of every candidate to know and take appropriate stand for himself .

Dr. Mukesh Gupta : just like Deepak waited to confirm & then informed us . We also were waiting for audit report to see if something serious has happened . the auditors are taking screen shots not all the reports , data bases , tables etc , they have also created a virtual walk thru of the entire process for giving a valid written report . 7/8 technicians are working overnight nonstop on all aspects . EOs are representing each and every candidate and not a single candidate shall be made to suffer. We shall point out all the mistakes to this AGM if found serious.

Dr. Nilima Vaidya-Bhamare: EOs do not represent the candidates . investigations can go on side by side . But candidates contesting should have known that the election process has been hampered so they can take appropriate timely action . My question is , why will the internal auditor appointed by Nityam say that something wrong has happened . Many emails were sent to the EOs to appoint one more auditor so that no one shall be able to point fingers later that we took a hasty decision . This is in the interest of the association only . Any process of auditing takes time . Auditor was appointed at 10.30 last night . Why are we in so much of a hurry about auditing Candidates needed to know ...that was not done . That was a wrong process . Auditing was handed over to only one external auditor & one more needed to be appointed as this was important as the entire process of election where the vendor has accepted that an error had occurred ... crash & truncation of data are important terms . Without the keys of all 3 EOs , no one should be able to open the data base . The very fact that this was interested with needs a detailed investigation . I am not even trying to contest the result . Whatever be the results I shall accept as long as we are able to prove that the process which was followed was correct & no tampering done . People are making unconstitutional demands . Our constitution clearly says agenda of AGM is election process of the committee . When you say committee , it legally means the whole committee , not part of the committee . It can't mean that part of the committee will be if the past year & part will be new . Since the election process is being questioned , the previous elected committee is answerable to the AGM & needs to continue till everything is clarified completely in writing . Request has been made to appoint one more auditor . Which has not been heeded to . The candidates have not been given a chance to voice their opinion at all . This is not a proper process .

Dr. S.S. Kambay : we should not delay installation of the unopposed candidates as majority are elected unopposed.

Dr. Nilima Vaidya-Bhamare: the whole committee needs to be installed , not part committee .

Dr. Manoj : in half an HR we will get the results so we can wait for a few more minutes so that full committee can be installed

Dr. Vikram Khanna: we can have the next agenda ie speeches of the outgoing & incoming president's. Once the audit report comes , the committee can be installed if clear .

Dr. Ketan Parikh : committee is a single structure . We cannot half this committee & half that taking over . Whole MC needs to be installed together . Last yr also the MC was installed after 1.5 months under unusual situation . Constitution does not make it obligatory to the AGM to install , only to identify the election process . Unusual situations needs unusual solutions

Dr. Mukesh Gupta : updates : Internal Auditor written report shall be available before the report of the external auditor as they had started work earlier . Both the auditors however categorically said that no foul play was detected in the logs .

Dr. Umesh Oza : President elect has been installed last year unless the current President wants to continue . He lauded the fabulous work done by him .

Dr. Deepak Baid : I have no problem about handing over to Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar as next President.

We however need to give a mandate to the truncated committee in any eventuality . So we need to devise a mechanism to take it forward for smooth functioning of the association .

Dr. Sudhir Naik : the process is already in place . The majority OB is elected unopposed . So also the area representatives are elected .

Dr. Deepak Baid : if I wanted to continue more , I would not have waited for one & a half month last year .

Dr. Mukesh Gupta was finally asked to hand over charge by the MCM to me .

Dr. Vipin Checker : Let the unopposed candidates be installed .

Dr. Niranjana Agarwal : even in the chat majority are in agreement that the new committee be installed
Dr. Vikram Khanna: since the auditors have ruled out foul play , so let's not waste time

Dr. Nilima Vaidya-Bhamare: Can I present the work done by us in the last year ?

Dr. Deepak Baid let Dr. Manasvi speak then you present .

Dr. Manasvi :

I have suffered at the hands of AMC . it has taken a toll on my reputation as well . My software team had developed an EMS for patient & drsalong with mechanism to prevent violence against drs . I wanted to help the drs all over with real time emergency help . My proposal was accepted by previous managing committee . I gave a donation & was promised a few things . Then COVID came & a few promises could not be fulfilled . For 9 months I has been trying to raise this issue about the pending promises & I was stone walled . I was told that the promise was given by last President& had to be fulfilled by him . But I said that donation was made to AMC so the pending promises need to be fulfilled by the incoming committee . I tried communicating to President , Secretary , IPP . But everybody was helpless and no official clarification was made to me asking what is the problem .

The platform needs to be run by collecting fees from the drs or service providers & patients . The committee thought that I was wanting a commission . But no one discussed it with me . I could have explained . I have lost a lot of time in between a lot of other applications have come in . So my venture has gone into a stone wall . On the false pretext that we were taking a commission my efforts have gone waste . My reputation is at stake . I have lost a lot of money too .

Dr. Deepak Baid :

We discussed this in the OB . There was an element of commission in ur proposal . After talking about it to you , you said you will change ur app to subscription model .

Dr. Anshuman : Dr. Nilima Vaidya-Bhamare was also aware .

Dr. Nilima Vaidya-Bhamare: Pl do not drag me into the conversation as i was not party to your agreement with Dr. Mukesh Gupta . Even though I was Secretary , I was not party to the nitty gritty of agreement which was done with Dr. Mukesh Gupta. I had given my go ahead to any solution mutually agreeable to all parties . I tried my best to communicate everything to all concerned .

Dr. Deepak Baid : We requested u to remove the element of commission which u gracefully agreed to . Then script for SMS to be circulated was asked for & circulated . Delay was regretted

Dr. Mukesh Gupta : AGM could not be held , even Grasp was not brought out , so commitment could not be fulfilled due to COVID . There were no physical meetings happening . The OB is nearly the same .

Dr. Anshuman : One of the AMC MC members had a personal grudge against me as I refused to give it free to him .

Dr. Abhay Dalvie : RO has gone on record to say that election results shall not be declared till a written report of both auditors is available . So now he cannot turn back & ask permission to go ahead with only one report Majority gave permission to go ahead with declaration of results with one auditors report .

Dr. Vipin Checker: Consensus has been reached about declaration of the unopposed candidates.

It was decided that all 3 EOs shall be physically present at AMC office along with the candidates , tribunal & Nityam and then the keys will be put in for obtaining the results for permission from AGM

Dr. Abhay : it is not necessary for every one to be physically present to key in .

10.00 am Dr. Pradeep Baliga welcomes the members to the Special General Body Meeting of AMC. Due to lack of quorum the meeting is adjourned by 15 minutes.

10.15 am Dr. Baliga calls the meeting to order and requests President Madam to initiate the proceedings.

President Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar greets the members with good wishes in the golden jubilee year of AMC. She requested all to remain cordial and respectful to each other so that there could be short and successful meeting. Before starting the meeting, she mentioned that due diligence was taken and notice was posted on 1st Jan 2022, at Registered Office, taking care to inform members in advance, as mandated. Subsequently it was posted on AMC website and mobile App, fulfilling the criteria of 21 days. The MC and OB are in the loop regarding the SGBM.

She mentioned the process of this special AGM wherein every member will be unmuted and allowed to speak, in rotation, after member raises virtual hand. This arrangement is made for the smooth functioning of the meeting, as we are on virtual platform, and not to deny right of the member to speak.

President madam informed the agenda of the meeting as **“To address issues related to 2021 election complaints and deliberate on appropriate actions to be taken”**.

The SGBM had been called as there were three complaints following the AMC elections 2021, from Dr. Debraj Shome, Dr. Vivek Dwivedi and Dr. Dhiren Kalawadia, with the Election Tribunal. The Tribunal had to take action and decided to hold third audit after multiple discussions. The report of this audit was received on 10th November 2021, and was discussed in the 4th MCM on 28th November 2021, held at the new AMC Office. The MC deliberated on this matter in a great detail. Some recommendations came out of this. The audit report asked for a reelection, but, the MC decided that it is too late to hold reelection. As the calling of choice of reelection or not, rests with the GB, it was brought for discussion in this SGBM. Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar reiterated that she is only doing her duty as mandated by the MC, without any bias or prejudice. Many issues came up during MCM, hence, to protect the fairness of upcoming AMC elections 2022, this meeting was essential. She invited head of the Tribunal Dr. Niranjana Agarwal to present the audit report.

Dr. Niranjana Agarwal described that the elections fought in March 2021 were as never before. The issues raised and the conduct of elections are known to all. Unfortunately, it happened just before the upcoming golden jubilee year of AMC. It made us sad. Elections were fought before also. But, the allegations, counter allegations, among the people who were supposed to conduct the elections, were so high and so were the interpretations of the constitution, twisted so vehemently, to suit the individual goals. We got the legal notice, even before the election results were declared. The AGM said to go ahead after the first two audits were rushed through within a day and a half. It was decided that a third audit will be done in the need arises or further complaints came up. The name of the association had to be cleared. As there were complaints after the results, we were compelled to go for the third audit. Lot of time was lost in the preparation for the same – contacting the complainants, getting their statements, report from Nityam after signing NDA with them, etc. Finally an agency, recognized by the government was found with a task of thorough forensic audit of every election trail, so that not even an iota of doubt remained in the mind of anybody, about the fairness of elections. Lot of paperwork and data sharing were to be done, from many sides. Due to the pandemic affecting many people/families involved in these activities, the whole process got delayed. Ultimately, the physical interrogation took place and the report was given to us on 10th November 2021.

There are two parts of the report. One is the actual forensic trails of election, data which was there etc. The second is the part of physical interrogation of the person suspected to have truncated the data. The first report said that no untoward incident has happened in truncating and we can go ahead with the results. They suggested some kind of security network has to be there so that any suspicion should be avoided in future. The interrogation was conducted by the chief of cybercrime, Mr. Harold D'Costa, with Nityam team and three Tribunal members, and the Managing Trustee being available in the office. There were certain questions which the Nityam team was not able to answer. It was concluded that the system was not entirely foolproof and Nityam did not take certain measures to prevent cyber assault that could occur. That is the reason they concluded that it is difficult to say that free and fare elections have taken place, and, reelection should occur. This report was paced before the MC Meeting held on 20th November 2021. Discussion took place. In the larger interest of the organization and because the forensic audit did not find anything except security lapses in the system, lacunae in the system of Nityam, we decided that there should be no reelection. Especially in the golden year of AMC we should not send a message, which would start pointing fingers towards the organization. The complainant readily agreed to this and was prepared to withdraw the complaint. The interest of the organization should be protected first. The MC recommended that we must not have a reelection. However the MC and the Tribunal are not the sole authority and such kind of major decision lies with the General Body. We want your endorsement for the same. That is the first thing.

Then, there were issues raised during MC Meeting, in the three audits conducted and while checking the trail mails, we found that some sort of course correction must be done. After having spent so much time, energy and money, we have to prevent occurrence of such kind of incidents, in future.

The first and foremost lacuna is the system which we have for election, which needs safety-guard. The software must be audited pre-election, so that we ensure that nothing can be tampered with during election. Whichever agency is employed to conduct election, it must be ensured that there are no loopholes in the system.

Secondly, during the election, the constitution was twisted, as per personal whims and fancies. I recommend that a committee be set up, that will look in to all the lacunae and ensure that nobody will misuse their powers. Let the General Body give the powers to the committee so that even in this year the elections are conducted in a free and fair manner. A formal amendment can be taken up later.

We have an arrangement that the three past Presidents become the election officers. Somewhere down the line we have realized that it is not a good idea. During this election multiple biases were observed. People, who are directly or indirectly connected with the election process this year, must take a moral responsibility to stay away from becoming election officers. During this election at least, let GB recommend some other three past Presidents to conduct the election. It requires a constitutional amendment. We can take up the discussion in the upcoming GB Meeting, later this year. We should ensure that the upcoming election must not be marred by the biases, egos, etc., which show the Association in a poor light. This is the third recommendation. Over to President Madam.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar: Thank you Dr. Niranjana for giving very concise report of the entire events that happened. We must hear a few things from Dr. Smita Sharma, who was the Chief Election Officer, following which we can start discussions.

Dr. Smita Sharma: I have the full report of election process with all the trails, all the conversations, all where the constitution was interpreted wrongly and several other biases. I am going to hold it right now. But, as the purpose of this meeting is to harmoniously solve everything, not to create any disharmony. I will bring it up only if required. I think we can give others chance to talk. First of all, is the house agreeable to the proposal of Head of the Tribunal.

Dr. Niranjana: This is what I feel, but the General Body must have a say. If we start the discussion, the allegations and counter allegations will start. We are all here to safeguard the interest of the Association. We may have difference of opinion. Everybody agrees that the software needs to be audited before election and necessary safeguards to be taken. Let us take the proposals one by one.

Does the house agree that there should be no reelection?

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar: Let us enable the chat and ask members who have raised their hands to speak. She named members who had raised their hands, one by one, enabling them to speak.

Dr. Jignesh Thakkar: We have gone through such experience with Nityam in 2018, in Radiology Association. There is no system which is foolproof. He gave information of the case wherein more than 15 lakh rupees were spent in prolonged court cases, after a defeat in an election. Let there be a committee to decide how to campaign and hold the election. There cannot be any personal “my way” of conducting the election. Let there be rules of campaigning and moral code of conduct. Action will be taken if someone does not follow the code. Let there be a system in place to avoid things going murkier. Only those who follow will contest. The mudslinging must not be allowed. No reelection; let bygones are bygones. Let there be a proper robust system in place. Let us go with the positivity. Thank you.

Dr. Dhiren Kalawadia: I was one of the complainants. I had asked for certain things to be provided from the election commissioners. First was the agreement/MOU signed between AMC and Nityam. Second was the agreement between AMC and each of the Auditors investigating apprehensions and complaints cast by the contestants on Nityam. Third was the auditors’ reports. The last was the Candidate audit trail and voter audit trail from Nityam. I was told to sign a confidentiality agreement as Nityam was insisting for it. As a member of AMC it is my right to have, the agreement between AMC & Nityam. It was not given to me. Agreement between AMC & Auditors was not given, so also the report from auditors, given before the last AGM. I agree with what Dr. Niranjana said about plugging the loopholes and having a robust system in place so that there will be transparency and confidence in the system. If there is a rule, it must be applicable to all, no one can be above rules. If changes are made, must be made applicable to everyone, cannot be selective. Like election officers, even Tribunal members also, directly or indirectly, must not take part in the election process. Both, the election commission and Tribunal must stay away from election process.

Dr. Sangeeta Pikale: My questions: 1. Who forms the tribunal? 2. What are the criteria or eligibility for the tribunal?

Dr. Niranjana Agarwal: The Tribunal is made as per the constitutional direction. They are supposed to take all complaints post-election. The head of the Tribunal is the Managing Trustee. Two more Trustees are appointed. Dr. S. S. Khambay and Dr. Shrikant Badwe along with me were part of the Tribunal.

Dr. Sangeeta Pikale: So, the Tribunal is also a part of the regular Managing Committee. The third question is: Whether the Managing Trustee or the other two Trustees, who were the tribunal, were they part of election campaigning? Were they supporting any candidate in the election?

Dr. Niranjana Agarwal: There is no constitutional provision which prevents them from doing so.

Dr. Sangeeta Pikale: Usually a Tribunal has to be nonbiased. If it has to judge, cannot be part of the same campaigning. The whole authenticity of the tribunal falls apart. A judge cannot be a part of the same discussion. The constitution of India and the laws of the land clearly define who can or cannot be a tribunal person. There are things from moral turpitude etc. There are multiple citations from the courts. Repeated her question.

Dr. Niranjana Agarwal: I repeat again, we follow our constitution, which is silent on this. That is why I have suggested forming a committee to look in to the lacunae. The scrutiny committee, before election, also had suggested then President, not to take any sides. He vehemently refused saying there is no such thing in the constitution. Actually, it is clearly mentioned that the President has the casting vote. In spite of that he chose to campaign for one candidate and agreed that the others can also do so. Despite that none of the Tribunal members campaigned in groups. They only sent personal messages, only to their close contacts. We can only discuss constitution of AMC in this meeting and not beyond that.

Dr. Sangeeta Pikale: This kind of a tribunal is prima facie failure as an unbiased tribunal. MC members taking part in a discussion, becoming part of the Tribunal, and then deciding on MC. Were the FAMCI President and other OB campaigning? What is the time limit put to the Tribunal? Is the new committee going to be formed among the MC, by the MC?

Dr. Niranjana Agarwal: The new committee formation is for the AGM to decide. We are trying to find out lacunae and to correct them. One has to take the things in the right spirit.

Dr. Sangeeta Pikale: A very small number of AMC members are joining this meeting. My last question is, in the MC, among the voting members how many are elected and how many are nominated members?

Dr. Niranjana Agarwal: That is beyond the discussion of the SGBM.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar tried to intervene, was interrupted.

Dr. Sangeeta Pikale: Holding of SGBM was the decision of the MC, after the 4th MC meeting. That is why it is important, who are the voting members in the MC. My other questions, unanswered, are raised in the chat box or may be sent by mail. I rest my case.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar: Madam, all your questions are noted. We have not even discussed here, so many things that happened last year. Let it be discussed in a separate forum. This is not what we are here for.

Calls the next speaker.

Dr. Smita Sharma: Want to answer some questions which come under my purview. The special amendment was passed in 2019 that all the co-opted members do not have the right to vote, they can participate in the discussion in the MC.

Dr. Sangeeta Pikale: Co-opted members are those only co-opted by the President. I am saying about the nominated members, means, Chairpersons, Zonal directors and others.

Dr. Smita Sharma: Please read the constitution to get the answers. About campaigning, it is very clear that the Returning Officers (R.O) cannot canvass. But, one R.O. did campaigning for one contestant, said he did not want to be a R.O. Then, changed his mind and remained as one. I have all the trails with me but, do not want to bring it here now. One R.O. has blatantly campaigned. About the question from Dr. Kalawadia, every year there is M.O.U. signed between AMC and Nityam.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Smita Sharma and calls the next speaker.

Dr. Sudhir Naik: Appreciated the way Dr. Niranjana Agarwal presented the report of the Tribunal. He regretted that some seniors are trying to rub salt on the wounds which we are keen to close. Due to some lacunae in the system some unethical things were done by some people, and we need to rectify the same. As responsible seniors we must understand that situation, because if such things continue to happen, the reputation of the association will be in trouble. Dr. Pikale's suggestions were incorporated earlier when she was in the review committee and her suggestions today will also be looked in to. The pointed questions regarding the morality are uncalled for. We trust our Tribunal members to be impartial. They have been exemplary this year, having been impartial in the past. We are not here to see what went wrong. We did see certain things were done wrongly, must not occur this year also. The vicious campaigning that happened in the past should not be occurring. Members are getting frustrated with the amount of canvassing done. Abusing in social media has to stop. Let there be well defined way of campaigning. If AGM cannot form a committee to improve the system, I fail to understand which body can do it. I have my strong objections to the use of the words like impropriety, immorality, unethical, etc., which must be avoided, in future too.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Naik and calls the next speaker.

Dr. Hemant Dugad: Nityam is conducting our elections for many years, we had lots of complaints against it, even in Lion's club. Yes, agree with D. Niranjana and Dr. Jignesh, that no system is foolproof. It is very difficult whether a pre or post-election audit is done. The server is in control of the agency. The pin with which login was done, voting process started, completed and results obtained. There is always a probability that the pin can be misused. No auditor of whatever repute can give a categorical answer that the system is foolproof. Not possible. It ultimately boils down to the people who are conducting the elections. The discussion should bring us to harmonious conclusion, so that as many possible loopholes can be plugged so that in future we have a better system to conduct the elections. Past Presidents, some leaders and senior members of MC can constitute the committee. Seniors should take cognizance of the lacunae and sit together unbiasedly, to plug the loopholes and see that AMC in the golden jubilee year is better in the next 50 years than the last 50 years.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Dugad. She said there are lots of points to be discussed, but, did not bring out those points. Our purpose is to resolve and have a proper discussion on this. So far this is going on in a unilateral way where members may not be aware of all the incidents which happened during the elections last year and that those points should be informed now. I request Dr. Niranjana and Dr. Smita to take over.

Dr. Niranjana Agarwal: Our intention is clear. These discussions will never end. We want the association to be functioning in a better way, and we want to plug the loopholes. Forget if some people think in a different way. Majority here want the elections to take place in a friendly way. Let us forget the negative things and go ahead with positive thoughts. That is what my proposal would be.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Niranjana, calls next speaker.

Dr. Shrikant Badwe: We have to go further rather than digging the old things. Otherwise the meeting will be unending.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Badwe, calls next speaker.

Dr. Deepak Baid: Appreciated the way the meeting is going. Absolutely agree with Dr. Niranjana also. 1. There should not be any reelection. 2. We need to relook the way and pattern in which we should go ahead. Because, it is absolutely not right, though it is not there in the constitution, we should not be campaigning. My suggestion is the President, the Past President and President Elect, election officers and Tribunal should ideally be not campaigning, at all. Office Bearers campaigning may be plus or minus. Whichever committee is formed let invitations be sent to all past presidents to be part of the committee, whoever wishes to join. Let the association be more like an association than the actual way it is going on. We have a beautiful association to look for. In the MC we do have the discrepancy as far as the voting rights are concerned. We need to look in to this also. Out of 60 people only 20 are the elected people. The elected people must have the heavier say than the nominated people.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Baid and calls the next speaker.

Dr. Sangeeta Pikale: Legally this particular Tribunal is invalid. A constitutional amendment is needed, very urgently on this. Our constitution cannot be held valid or legal if it is not in line the law of the society's act, land, constitution of India and constitution with the charity commissioner.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Pikale, calls the next speaker.

Dr. Arshad Gulam Mohammad: There are two issues I can identify. One is the re-election and the other one is smoothening of election process. All SGBMs are agenda specific. As far as re-election is concerned, everyone has understood by now. Cases filed before the results are announced are quite different from the ones done after the announcement. Courts in general are not amenable to admit the petitions which are filed after the results are announced. If you analyse these cases, you will find that overwhelmingly large number of cases went against the petitioner. So there is no case, as far as I think, for re-election. Unless we want to make laughing stock of ourselves, I do not think even we should think in those lines. Making the election process smoother is always welcome. I am with the decision of GB in this. Thank you.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Arshad and calls the next speaker.

Dr. Rajeev Agarwal: Agree with Dr. Niranjana. We should form a committee of seniors. Let the election process be made better for everyone, with a happy ending. Let the upcoming elections will not have such happenings as seen in the past. Thank you.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Rajeev and calls next speaker.

Dr. Abhay Dalvi: I go with majority opinion in the chat box saying no to re-election. As far as the guidelines to smoothening the process, let there be a committee to suggest the same and come before a proper AGM, as an agenda. Thanks.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Dalvi. She thanks everyone for their opinions and suggestions. To conclude, she mentioned that she would like to emphasize whatever discussion we had today.

First of all, there will be no re-election, as agreed upon by the SGBM.

Secondly there will be a committee to look in to the election matter. All the matters will be presented by everyone, whoever wants to.

Thirdly we will have a new election vendor, after asking for quotations. Three election officers must be selected for this year, as per the discussion. The elections this year will be held before the proposed committee presents its report. So, we need to select the election officers right now. The last point as suggested by many that the constitutional amendments are required. The committee looking in to all election matters will also urgently look in to this. This can be presented in the AGM this year. Now, three election officers for this year must be named. She requests Dr. Niranjana to speak on this.

Dr. Niranjana Agarwal: Congratulated President Madam for conducting SGBM in a nice manner. He congratulated all the members who opined in the interest of the Association. We look forward to working together in a nice atmosphere. He thanked all, Dr. Deepak and Dr. Nilima, in particular, because we want to

be with you all and do not want to exclude anyone from anywhere. That is the message we want to give. As far as three election officers for this year, I would like to recommend three people with impeccable integrity; they are Dr. Suresh Rao, Dr. Umesh Oza and Dr. S. N. Agarwal. If everyone agrees, we can go ahead.

President Madam seconded the proposal. It is an excellent suggestion, she added. Dr. Baliga fully agreed with the proposal.

Dr. Niranjana Agarwal: I think lot of people agreed in the chat box also. So, we can have the final conclusion on this.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar concurred, said majority seem to agree. That is great. Together we will resolve all the differences and go ahead. We will emerge victorious. She thanked all, and concluded the meeting.

Dr. Niranjana Agarwal also thanked all the members.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar: Let members who have not spoken so far also express their opinion.

Dr. Mukesh Gupta: Thank you. It is really difficult for one to join as election officer and see all the friends fighting the elections. It becomes not only moral but also ethical dilemma for everyone. This is really nice way to look in to it. He reiterated that as election officers they tried to do the best to see to it that it was conducted in a fair way.

Dr. Suhas Kate: I agree with Dr. Niranjana when he named election officers. My two questions are: On what criteria these people are selected. Have they been asked whether they are willing to become election officers? Thank you.

Dr. Niranjana Agarwal: Answering the questions said there were no fixed criteria over here. I just put a proposal and everybody is agreeing. The second question is really valid. I will take the moral responsibility to convince them.

Dr. Nilima Bhamare: Thanked all for their faith in her to become the President of the association next year. I look to working with everyone harmoniously. I am not happy with the way the next tribunal is announced. A proper MC meet has to happen; constitutional amendment is needed before we have such a tribunal. Because in the recent amendment, there is a provision made in the constitution to make it unbiased, that the past three Presidents only can become the election officers. When the amendment is made and passed in the solid AGM, I do not think a SGBM which is poorly attended and only some people here are agreeing, I do not think it is acceptable. Three names given are absolutely fabulous, I agree with their honesty and credibility. But, that does not mean the others are not honest or credible. I think it should be rehashed. I do not think it can be passed as it has no validity. Constitution cannot be flouted just like that, in a SGBM. We have to follow the processes which are laid down already. It can so happen tomorrow that people will come together in SGBM, pass something else. That is not the right way to go ahead. It is again my request to you all, as the President next year, the question of re-election must be decided on the basis of audit report, which has said there is no tampering, forensic audit also said there is no tampering, so the people who have won, have won on their merit. Let us not put an iota of doubt in the minds of common members that the upcoming committee or President has won by fraud. Recommendations of the third audit have been taken up. Two lakh rupees of the association are spent for the third audit, without presenting the audit report, accepting it in SGBM is not acceptable. Why are we accepting the third audit when two audits have cleared all kinds of allegations made about election tampering and the result was declared? After the results questioning the verdict of election officers is not acceptable. The process of selecting election officers is clearly mentioned in the constitution, flouting that by SGBM called without a specific agenda is not acceptable. Thank you.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Nilima and calls the next speaker.

Dr. Vikram Khanna: Thank you, President Madam. Let me congratulate each member attending the SGBM, which is conducted in a very dignified manner, without casting any aspersions on each other. I completely agree that there should be no re-election. Consent of the three persons should have been taken before announcing their names. Since Dr. Niranjana has taken the moral responsibility, we can go ahead with it. We have the constitutional provision in place regarding who should be the election officers, the decision of this SGBM must not be held against that and a new controversy must not be created. That is my only concern. Thank you.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Vikram, calls the next speaker.

Dr. Rajeev Agarwal: Election officers are appointed now, let the SGBM appoint the Tribunal also. We can appoint the committee also and invite persons interested to join.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Rajeev, calls the next speaker.

Dr. Niranjana Agarwal: There is a process of calling a GBM. There is a process of fulfilling the quorum also. The attendance is defined in the constitution. Those who attend and make their say, their votes are counted. The notice has gone to all. Those who are present and speaking are not four or five. You can see the numbers attending in the chat box. Constitutional amendments are also done in the GB. The proposal here was to take things forward. I have said we have some lacunae in our system. The three IPP becoming election officers. This election has seen the President fighting with the election officers, more than the candidates fighting the elections. To overcome that, this suggestion is for this year at least. Then further discussions can be held at the proper AGM and suitable constitutional amendment can be made. The recommendations were made to overcome all these lacunae and take the association forward these recommendations are made. I take this guarantee that all three named will oblige us, because they are hard core AMCites and they want the interest of the association to be protected. It does not mean that the others are not capable. But, there is a limitation about how many people we can have. And the suggestion is accepted by all. Let us move forward from here. And come back in the main AGM with whatever lacunae we have to correct and we correct. That is what I have to say.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Niranjana and invites Dr. Kapoor Sir.

Dr. Lalit Kapoor: This is a historic opportunity for all of us to rise above constitution, to rise above rules, to rise above court case, rise above legal challenges. This is a historic opportunity to give a mature decision. We really need to stick to the spirit, to understand the spirit behind what Dr. Niranjana Agarwal said in his remarks. This is something after narration of such a good kind of direction which Dr. Niranjana gave to this audience. For us to go back to rules, go back to constitution is not going to lead us anywhere and that was the purpose. In fact please remember that the chief election officer of last election, though I believe that she has made mention of the various lapses, various misconduct, in this spirit she has been asked or she herself volunteered not to make that presentation. The whole idea is not to go back in to the unpleasant happenings of the past and to rise above it. We have to understand something about the spirit of it. This GB meeting is a valid GB meeting, which represents 12,000 members. Nobody has prevented anybody from joining this meeting. Even if tomorrow if you were to call another GB meeting for amending the constitution, even this many people may not come. That does not mean they have no right. That is the General body. This GB agrees with the spirit of what Dr. Agarwal has said, I think we should not go back again to all the constitutionalities which is the cause of so many problems and so many speakers have said in the earlier discussion, that it serves nobody's purpose to be going in to various kinds of litigation and legal challenges and so on. So my earnest request to everybody is to rise above all this and to take it in the spirit, particularly in the year, which marks the 50th year of the existence of the association. Let us be mature enough, to accept that this GB does have a power of going beyond the constitution and to suggest something which is in the interest of the association in the future. This is my earnest request. Thank you.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Kapoor Sir, calls the next speaker.

Dr. Sujata Rao: Thanks Madam. Congratulations for the manner in which you have conducted this SGBM, with the help of head of the Tribunal, Dr. Niranjana Agarwal. Actually, very impressed with the smooth process. It is very unfortunate that I have to talk after Dr. Kapoor Sir, I am sure most of us agree with the wise words spoken by him. My two bits: we have been talking round and round, about reforms, amendments, changes. We want to plug the loopholes. But, when we attempt to do it legs are pulled back to the same mundane and the routine constitutional requirements. Here is an extraordinary SGBM, due to extraordinary circumstances that led to the election fiasco last year. So it requires extraordinary attempts to change that. For that the SGBM is enough because the agenda has been sent, the agenda has been discussed, every point of it has been discussed in the right spirit. I see no reason to drag our feet again, because of constitutional amendments. In my view if at all there has to be any constitutional amendment, it should be that any discord between the MC members, that MC must resolve. What have we come together for? We have come together to represent the ordinary doctors in the cities, across our state. Are we here only to follow the constitutional amendments? It must be changed. The interpretations change according to the person who holds that post. The post is not illegal or immoral or anything. The person has to rise above that post in ethical and judicious manner. I do not think any amendment is going to allow that. We have to rise above the occasion, have to see that these extraordinary

fiascos that we have witnesses last year, which has disappointed all our members, across the membership has to change. That is why my vote goes to what Dr. Niranjan has said about creating a new set of election officers. I think this SGB is very much empowered to create an extraordinary result on this discussion. Thank you.

Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar thanks Dr. Sujata. Dr. Ketan Parikh has probably joined in a little later, has raised his hand to speak. Since I have already closed the meeting I will just read out what he has written in chat box. There was no agenda suggesting reforms in the constitution. But, we have not decided everything beforehand. Everything was supposed to be presented and discussed. I am sure there will be some people who will feel that we are doing something wrong. But, please be assured that, all this is done with the interest of the association, so that we are moving ahead positively. There is nothing that is done with any negative thought in the mind. Thank you everyone. Thanks to all who have given their valuable suggestions and comments. Everything that you all have said is taken in to account and noted. Thank you and have a good day.

In 2017-2018 our claim ratio was very high at 126% .Still we increased only 10% premium rates first time after 12 consecutive years and added 10% co-payment by all above 55 years of age. Cashless facility was also started. For 2019-2020 To encourage the younger age group to join our scheme we have decided to give no claim bonus of 5% for every claim free year (Maximum up to 20%) up to the age of 60 years & 5% to 10% for the age group 61-70 (Main Member & Spouse). Our projected claims ratio for this year is 85%.

TPA service has been continued this year with Paramount healthcare services as our TPA.
In last 2 years we have spent over 4 Crore from our corpus to take care of our member's health. Members contributed nothing.

OUR NEW RESOLUTIONS FOR 2020-2021

- 1) No payment from TOP Up policy towards chronic ailments/cases.
- 2) CSI shall be reduced in chronic cases e.g. CKD, Heart ailments etc.
- 3) Co-payment of 10% above age of 55 years for all the cases excluding capping disorders/diseases shall continue.
- 4) No loading in all claims in all age groups.
- 5) Premia are suitable re organised according to age groups.
- 6) Cataract, hysterectomy, malignancy & cardiac illness not covered in initial 2 years for all and 3 years for those above age of 55 years. Hysterectomy and malignancy is fully covered from 3rd years onwards provided you have joined scheme below the age of 55 years. Otherwise it will be eligible from 4th year onwards only.

Medico-Legal Cell Report.

All respected Members are well aware that the new Consumer protection Act 2020 has been notified and is now in force. Unlike the view of some experts this law has not changed anything for the better for us doctors. Instead it has made life more difficult for us because it gives the patient the right to file a case against you even outside your place of practice. It has also increased the financial jurisdictions limits of the claims of the District and State Consumer forums and thus made it easy for the patients to file for higher claims of damages. However in term of new notifications of central government Dt. 30.12.2021 again claims of amount have been scaled down i.e. up to Rs 50 lacs for District Forum ,Rs 50 lacs to 2 Cr for State Commission and Rs 2 Cr. & above for National Commission. Members can rest assured that they have the best Professional Indemnity insurance policy in the country and the reasons to justify our claims are as follows.

FEATURES OF AMCs MEDICO LEGAL SCHEME

- 1.Exclusive expert Medico legal advisory services rendered by AMC Medico legal cell.
2. Expert Advocates appointed exclusively for AMC Members approved and authorized by The Oriental Insurance CO. Ltd.
3. Provision for out of court settlement in appropriate cases as determined by Medico Legal Cell on the advice from the AMC panel lawyers on a reimbursement basis.
4. End to end in-house scheme management by AMC
- 5.Complimentary additional 25% coverage over and above the sum insured from the Insurance Company. The complimentary additional coverage will be available for sum insured beyond 50 LAKHS subject to a maximum of 2 corers sum insured taken from the Insurance Company
- 6.Professional Indemnity Insurance policy is offered by The Oriental Insurance Company with below key features
 - A. Complaints before MMC, NHRC, and Competition Commission of India (CCI) covered under policy. B. Defence costs for criminal cases arising out of medical accidents, mishaps & operative deaths etc. covered on a reimbursement basis.
7. Cashless service for payment to AMC panel advocates as per schedule of fees.
8. Cosmetic procedures & surgery covered at an extra premium.
9. Travel expenses for attending National Commission for evidence etc. covered.
10. Cashless of decreed amount before appeal to the higher forums in case of awards against doctors.
10. In case a judgment of District or State Consumer Forum goes against you, the National Consumer forum expects you to deposit the 50% amount awarded against you with the court within one month of such judgement before it admits your appeal. It is only the AMC scheme wherein this amount is paid directly by the Insurance Company. Other policies normally ask you to deposit the amount and pay you only if the Final Appeal is lost.

11. AMC scheme provides for 'Out of Court' settlements. Settlements up to Rs.10 lakhs purely on the recommendations of the AMC Medico legal cell and higher amounts in consultation with the Insurance company lawyers

12. AMC scheme provides for hiring expert lawyers and top doctors as Expert witnesses if required in some case on the recommendation of the AMC Medico legal cell. Needless to say this is also paid for by the scheme with no burden on the members.

13. AMC has a dedicated team for processing of claims and members need not interact directly with the Insurance Company. Being group insurance policy members will not be left stranded in case the persons who sold you an alternative policy leave the company or the organization. The solid experience of decades backed with a system in place for processing claims makes our AMC scheme unbeatable.

14. The recent trend has been for patients to file complaints in multiple forums like MMC, FDA Human Rights Commission, Competition Commission, etc. The AMC PI Scheme covers defence costs in all these forums too.

15. AMC scheme is now available on a Mobile app wherein you can make payments, download your receipts, policy copies or even upload claim forms. The app provides the convenience of managing your policy at the tip of your fingers.

16. Our claim ratio is 1:1

In the current fiscal due to our negotiations with the Insurance Company we have been able to give a massive of maximum up to 35% discount of the membership fees to our members as compared to our fees in the last 2 years. We are aware that several organizations are trying to copy our policy and claim to provide all the features of our policy at lower price. We would caution of our members against such fly by night companies which could leave you stranded in the event of a claim against you. We urge you to look for value and not for price. As stated earlier in view of the New Consumer Protection act making the probability of higher sums being awarded against doctors.

We urge members to enhance their sum insured and we recommend minimum cover of 2 corers for surgeons and Rs. 1.25 corer for physicians. This being an unusual year, we did face issues of complaints against our agents for laxity in the service provided to members. We have taken action in some of them and are examining their service records closely to ensure better accountability to the members and towards the Association. We would urge members to keep a track of their renewal premiums/receipts/policy copies through their agents and complain to us at supportmlc@amcmumbai.org if they are unresponsive or behave in a high handed manner.

In addition to the medico legal issues the Medico legal cell has also kept a close watch on issues relating to the medical profession. We were interveners in a Writ Petition filed by the Vidharba hospital owners association against the capping of charges for Non Covid cases. We have also intervened in the Supreme Court in the Appeal filed by R.G Stone clinic against an order of the National Consumer forum holding pre-printed consent forms as unfair trade practice. We do hope to put forth a strong case against the same as the implications of this judgment can be huge for all of us. We are also examining the possibility of filing a PIL or a Writ petition against the government of India allowing Ayush doctors to perform specific surgeries. Members should note that while many policies are claiming to offer "Out of Court settlements' ours is the only policy till date with an established protocol for the same and with a proven record of closing several cases in this manner.



NOAH Cell Report

In Continuation of helping society during Covid Pandemic AMC NoAH Cell donated 1000 N95 masks to TATA Institute, Khargar.

We also helped medical students whose Corona Rakshak policy premium was paid by AMC, get reimbursement from the insurance company smoothly.

The third program of AMC 2021-2022 was primarily a NOAH Cell initiative and was based on the **Fire Issues in a Nursing Home** with MMC accreditation points. The program was held on 23rd May 2021 and we had members from the affiliate cells namely Dr. Nilesh Naphade, Secretary -AMC Ratnagiri, Dr. Chetan Mhaske, Executive committee member -AMC Pune, Dr. N. Nanivadekar -AMC Kolhapur, Dr. Mayur Sarode, Treasurer -AMC Nashik, and Dr. Pravinkumar Mundada, Secretary -AMC Udgir-Latur giving a brief of the situation in their respective area, concerning the fire issues. This was followed by a talk given by Mr. Rajesh Dubey on structural audit, Miss. Bhagyashree Varma on the electrical audit, and Mr. K. V. Hirwale who is the Chief Fire Officer, on the current situation of safety protocols of fire in a nursing home and he was also joined by Mr. Hemant Parab who is the Deputy Chief Fire Officer. This was followed by a panel discussion that was well moderated by Dr. Niranjan Agarwal and Dr. Ashok Shukla. The panel was also joined by Dr. Suresh Rao, Chairman of the NOAH cell. The program reached its conclusion with a satisfactory question and answer session.

We had a meeting our office 08.12.2021 at 3.30pm with fire officer covering areas between Bandra to Andheri and our members who were having issues with fire compliance, attended and resolved.

In Mira-Bhayander Municipal Corporation we were able to get MBMC registered Electric and structural auditors give uniform quotes with essential requirements required after having multiple meets with concerned MBMC officers.

Under leadership of Dr. Niranjan Agarwal, Dr. Ashok Shukla and Dr. Vivek Dwivedi met MLA Smt. Geeta Jain and Additional Commissioner MBMC Corporation and got Audit requirements for Nursing homes modified so that Nursing homes can comply.

This helped our members getting their Electric and structural audits easily and faster.

The fire compliance issues of nursing homes have been taken up in a systematic manner and multiple meetings with Chief Fire Officer, Executive Health Officer, and the IT team of both departments have been done.

All difficulties faced by members were compiled and sent to them, on which the Fire department worked with their IT team and were able to resolve most of their issues related to fire compliance.

PROGRAM COMMITTEE REPORT

Our first program '**Naari Shakti" Season 1** was conceptualized by our President Prof. Sushmita Bhatnagar. The program was for the woman, by the woman and maximum attendees were women. Prominent speakers like Dr. Rujuta Mehta, Dr. Geetha Balsarkar, Dr. Purnima Mhatre gave excellent talks related to the health aspects of women. Ms. Nehal Mota gave an insight into how to become financially independent. This was followed by talks given by Celebrity Mrs. Kanchan Adhikari, who shared her Lessons of life. Prominent Celebrity Lawyer Advocate Mrunalini Deshmukh gave a talk on how to confront Patriarchy and it was concluded with a healthy audience interactive Session.

The third program was primarily a NOAH cell initiative and was based on the **Fire issues in a nursing home** with MMC accreditation points. The program was held on 23rd May 2021 and we had members from the affiliate cells namely Dr. Nilesh Naphade, Secretary – AMC Ratnagiri, Dr. Chetan Mhaske, Executive committee member AMC Pune, Dr. N. Nanivadekar AMC Kolhapur, Dr. Mayur Sarode, Treasurer – AMC Nashik, and Dr. Pravinkumar Mundada, Secretary – AMC Udgir-Latur giving a brief of the situation in their area concerning the fire issues. This was followed by a talk given by Mr. Rajesh Dubey on structural audit, Miss Bhagyashree Varma on the electrical audit, and Mr. K. V. Hirwale who is the Chief Fire Officer on the current situation of safety protocols of fire in a nursing home and he was also joined by Mr. Hemant Parab who is the deputy Chief Fire Officer. This was followed by a panel that was well moderated by Dr. Niranjana Agarwal and Dr. Ashok Shukla. The panel was also joined by Dr. Suresh Rao, Chairman of the NOAH cell. The program reached its conclusion with a satisfactory question and answer session.

The fourth program was a community program which was held on 6th June 2021 and focused on "**Corona se Muqabala**". We had with us Dr. Sanjeev Oak, the head of Covid task force Maharashtra, who gave a brief of working of the Taskforce, Dr. Mangala Gomare, Executive health officer of MCGM, who explained the work done by the municipal corporation during the pandemic, and Dr. Mahesh Reddy, DSP Andheri who shared the problems and adversities faced by the police and how they managed to overcome the same. Thus all of them shared experience of Covid from their respective work arena with the doctors and the general public attending the program. They were part of a panel discussion which was also joined by Dr. Ashesh Bhumkar from Maharashtra Mucormycosis task force, Mr. Shashikant Modh the district governor of Lions Club, and Mr. Sunil Mehra the district governor of Rotary Club. The session was well moderated by Dr. Sujata Rao and Dr. Rajeev Agarwal. A lot of Covid related information including the safety protocols, vaccinations, etc. were discussed and were shared with the general public to help create awareness and keep them safe.

On 20th June 2021, we celebrated **International Yoga day** in association with Iyengar Yogashraya which was the fifth program. The convenor of the program was Dr. Rajendra Chawhan. The introduction was given by Mr. Birjoo Mehta and Dr. Manoj Naik gave the practical demonstration. This was followed by a panel discussion on the experience and evidence on the efficacy of Yoga. The panelist were Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar, Dr. Anand Parihar, Dr. Viraj Tambekar, Dr. Rajvi Mehta and Dr. Taral Nagda. The Panel was moderated by Dr. Devdat Kapadia and Dr. Smita Sharma. The panel discussion was followed by an excellent audience interaction session.

All the audience highly appreciated the program which had excellent practical tips and also the importance of incorporating the Yoga practice in daily life was well explained.

We celebrated the **Doctor's day** program on 4th July 2021. The program was convened by Dr. Bipin Pandit. Many Celebrities extended their gratitude towards the work done by the doctors, especially during the Covid Pandemic. We got video greetings from Television actress Mrs. Jayati Bhatia, Producer Mr. Bharat Dabholkar, Singer Mr. Hariharan, Mr. Sanjeev Kapoor famous for khana khazana, and actor Mr. Ananth Mahadevan. We also had a very senior surgeon Dr. V. N. Shrikhande as the Guest of honour for the program. The Members who had lost their lives in the Covid Pandemic were paid tribute and the families of these COVID martyrs were invited to the program and presented with certificates. Then, we had with us the famous mentalist Mr. Nicolai Friedrich who performed Live online from Germany and interacted with the audience who were mesmerized with his jaw-dropping mentalism show and left all amazed. We also had a lucky draw with many prizes and a Question & Answer session. The show was complete entertainment and left the audience pondering over the magical tricks for many days after the event!

The financial independence series program **FINCON** was held on the 15th of August 2021 in association with Finnovate on an online platform and was attended by about 450 delegates. Dr. Rajeev Agarwal was the convenor, the first talk was by Mr. Shailendra Dubey who gave an excellent glimpse of the importance of making a will and the advantages of getting the will registered. This was followed by talk by CA Geeta Tolia who spoke on the much-needed topic of how to be a medical entrepreneur and how to manage nursing home finances. The third talk was taken up by Mr. Nilesh Chandra, the key note speaker who spoke on the various investment possibilities in the equity market and shared his own personal experiences on how to make profits by applying strategies. The fourth talk was taken by Mr. Subrata Biswas on the topic of insurance. He spoke on various insurance policies, their benefits, and how secure the policies are. The fifth talk was by Ms. Nehal Mota on financial life planning. She explained how the finances should be planned as per one's needs and also why a proper plan should be in place so to ensure financial freedom. These topics were followed by a very informative panel discussion moderated by Dr. Rajeev Agarwal and Dr. Vivek Dwivedi with Dr. Nitin Bhagali, Dr. Ramakant Deshpande, Dr. Ramesh Shah, and Ms. Nehal Mota being the panelist. There were many important questions taken up during the discussion and were answered crisply and to the point by the experts and they also shared their own personal experiences and investment strategies. Master class was taken up by CA Geeta Tolia on 28th August 2021. It was a part of the financial freedom series mainly focusing on money management in hospitals and nursing homes. This is a very important aspect which many a time is ignored. Calculation of expenses on a per bed basis with overall expenditure calculations was briefed. The delegates who attended benefited tremendously from micro-level financial management which was explained during the program

On 20th September 2021, we had associated with AFG and OBS. GYNAC Society of Mira-Bhayander to conduct **Nurses training program** which was well organized by our Senior and very active member Dr. S. N. Agarwal Sir. The program was physically held in Riddhi Vinayak hospital Nallasopara. About 450 people attended the program and various topics for nurses were Included, like CPR, Emergency management, ICU management, and many more and also how to reduce stress at the workplace. About 300 Certificates were given after the program and it was a very successful event.

Nari Shakti Season 2 - A journey from ordinary to the extraordinary - was conducted in collaboration with the Indian Dieticians Association Mumbai chapter on Saturday, 23rd October 2021, 3 pm onwards on zoom platform which reached across about 300 people on YouTube. We had put together a wonderful program on healthy diet and exercise tips to improve women's lifestyles. A talk was given by Secretary of IDA Ms. Ruby Sound on Smart Nutrition tips for 21st Century Women. Next was a presentation by Sports physician Dr. Tvisha Parikh on Zumba, Aerobics, Pilates. Next was a lecture cum live Yoga demonstration by Ms. Rajvi Mehta. A panel discussion was scheduled but since time was short, it was conducted on 20 November which was the second part. Many important topics related to healthy dietary habits and exercise regimes were discussed making it extremely beneficial to the members. We had the nation's first woman bodybuilder Ms. Karuna Waghmare who has won many awards nationally and internationally as the guest of honor. She spoke on her life journey and gave important information on how to be fit and keep yourself well maintained.

Then **FINCON 2** was held on 14th November in association with Finnovate on an online platform and was attended by about 350 delegates. There was a talk by Mr. Siddhant Raizada who spoke on the much-needed topic of Cryptocurrency and explained the technical aspect of working of the blockchain, its security part, and the volatility and gave a brief about the legal aspect and acceptance of it. The guest of honor and the Keynote

speaker Mr. Nilesh Shah, Managing Director of Kotak Mahindra AMC, gave the market idea in relation to the time phases and the ups and downs which happen during various decades. The various insights given by him will undoubtedly help all the members to decide how and where to invest. A brief session of fire chat financial OPD was taken up by Ms. Nehal Mota and the President Madam. Mr. Apoorva Vora, an expert in international investments explained the various types of investments that can be done in foreign markets and how to plan a proper strategy for the same. Then Dr. Dilip Raichura gave his view on physical assets i.e. gold and land. The first topic was on the Medico-legal landscape in the COVID era and was a panel discussion moderated by Dr. Sushmita Bhatnagar. Amongst the panelist were eminent personalities with Dr. Adv. Sujay Kantawala discussing the legal aspects, Dr. Rajesh Dere who was in charge of many Jumbo centers of Bombay Municipal corporation, gave many insights on the working and difficulties during COVID times by the government. We had Dr. Om Shrivastava who is from the D. Y. Patil Hospital group and also Dr. Sudhir Naik, the Chairman of the Medico-legal Cell, who raised the queries and problems of the doctors from the small nursing homes. The need for improving the healthcare system was elaborately discussed and also the need for setting protocols for future pandemics, if the need arises. Next was a talk by the in-charge president of the state consumer commission Maharashtra, Dr. Santosh Kakade. He spoke on the various changes in the new consumer protection act and also gave his insights on the procedure of compensation during a trial. Many key points were brought forward and also the steps to be taken by doctors during their practice to avoid medico-legal cases were also highlighted and appreciated by the audience. After this, there was a panel discussion on the differences between the National Medical Commission and State Medical Council and its impact on the doctors. The session was moderated by Dr. Sujata Rao and Dr. Lalit Kapoor, President FAMC, Dr. Shivkumar Utture, president Maharashtra Medical Council, and Adv. Sunil Khattri, part of the Legal Team AMC, were present as the panelists. Following this was the speech by chief guest Justice M. L. Tahliyani who spoke on the prevailing criminal law and what changes were needed. He emphasized the implementation of the existing law rather than major changes and also stressed on the need for competent personals and effective methods in the system to reduce the burden of manpower. He shared many personal experiences during his career and made it very interesting for the audience. The last panel discussion was on the living will and was well moderated by Dr. Lalit Kapoor. The panelist Dr. R.K. Mani from Delhi, Ms. Dhvani Mehta from the Vidhi foundation, and Dr. Roop Gursahani from Hinduja hospital were present on the online platform. The importance of understanding the living will from a different perspective was made understood to the audience by a very elaborate discussion on the legal aspects of the will and DNR and also the need for making it more transparent and patient-friendly in the future was stressed upon.

Celebrating the AMC golden Jubilee year, we had program by Brahma Kumari, Sister Shivani on **Healing with spiritual touch** and was held on 26 the January 2022 on the Zoom platform. It was a very insightful talk on the spiritual and a very practical approach to keep yourself away from the stress. This was to benefit the medical professionals who are having busy schedules and heavy workloads often leading to problems. The program provided solutions to the origins of the problems with correcting the mind status and proper programming of the subconscious in order to achieve positive results.

Covid update 2.0 program was held on 30th of January 2022 on the Zoom platform with more than 1000 registrations and were eligible for one MMC credit point. The first lecture was by Dr. Rahul Pandit who is the member of Maharashtra Covid task force on practical approach to current Covid treatment. He elaborated on the ways to differentiate the variants and to provide effective treatments along with the guidelines and protocols. The second lecture was by Dr. Suhas Prabhu who is the head of paediatric task force. He covered the paediatric aspect of Covid infection and treatment guidelines in details. This was followed by a question and answer session moderated by Dr. Rajeev Agarwal. The third lecture was by Dr. Nandini Kumar, who is former deputy director general of ICMR. She spoke on the current guidelines of ICMR and future directives and also gave a glimpse of ethical issues regarding vaccinations and research. The fourth lecture was by Dr. Ravindra Kembhve who is the professor community medicine in KEM Hospital and spoke all about the transmission and recurrence of Covid infections and also the importance of precaution dose and explained it in details. The last was the panel discussion on how to end the Covid pandemic with Dr. Vikram Khanna and

Dr. Qayyum Mukaddam, as the moderators. Among the panelists were Dr. Mangala Gomare, EHO Mr. Jehangir Gai, consumer activist, Dr. Rajendra Agarwal Past DG from Rotary Club, Dr. Tanu Singal, infectious disease specialist and Dr. Rajendra Kembhve. There was an excellent discussion on what are the current situation of the third wave and government protocols and also how the public responded and follow the Covid appropriate behaviour and the importance to continue them. The discussion also went about how to end the pandemic and how medical associations like AMC can come together along with the government officials to help tide over the pandemic now and also in future.

Before the year end AMC and TIMSCCDD (Thakur College) is jointly organising an international conference on 12th and 13th February with the focus on National Digital Health Mission which is going to have a lot of influence on Doctors, patients and the health care sector of our country.

The year was again in the shades of COVID pandemic waves but due to the positive spirit of AMC we could do many programs which has immensely benefitted the members. My sincere thanks to the Team AMC 2021-2022, all my seniors, colleagues and members of our pristine organisation to have supported all the programs throughout the year.

NOTES TO ACCOUNTS

Reg No. F-7373 Bom

Association of Medical Consultants (Mumbai) was formed in the year 1982. It is a registered charitable trust, registered under the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 (F-7373) and is also registered under Section 12AA of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

Basis of Preparation

The Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure account are prepared to comply with generally accepted accounting principles in India to the extent applicable to the Trust. These financial statements are prepared on cash basis. In the absence of any authoritatively established accounting principles for the specialised aspects related to charitable trusts which do not carry out any commercial activities, these statements have been prepared in accordance with Significant Accounting Policies as described below.

Method of Accounting

- 1 The Financial Statements are prepared on Cash Basis in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.

Fixed Assets

- 2 All Fixed Assets are stated at cost less depreciation.

Depreciation

- 3 Depreciation has been provided on the written down value basis at Rates as per Income tax act

Investments

- 4 Investments are stated at cost.

Corpus Fund

- 5 Membership receipts are credited to the Corpus funds appearing in the Balance Sheet. Donation received with specific directions that they should form a part of corpus are accounted accordingly.

Earmarked and Other Funds

- 6 Donation received with specific direction are credited directly to the earmarked and other funds in the Balance Sheet. Income from earmarked investments and expenditure on such activities are adjusted to specific earmarked activity funds.

Revenue Recognition

- 7 Membership and Subscription are recognised on Cash Basis as and when the subscription is received. Income from investments is recognised on cash basis, based on amount received and applicable interest rate. Revenue from other receipts if any, is recognised when the obligation is performed and money is received.

Income Tax

- 8 The trust is registered under Section 12AA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and under the provisions of this Act, the income of the Trust is exempt from tax subject to the compliance of terms and conditions specified therein.

During the year 2017-18 there was a significant delay in preparation and completion of accounts due to issues pertaining to softwares used by the Trust. Due to non completion of accounts on time, resulting delay of preparation of financials and non filing of tax return within the prescribed time limit, the Trust will be subjected to loss of benefits granted under the Income Tax Act, 1961. Consequently, the exemption available to the Trust under S 11 and S 12 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 will not be available to the Trust [S 12A(ba)]. This will mean that the Gross receipts will be chargeable to tax. The resulting tax and interest will be in excess of Rs. 87,00,000.

- 9 The Trust had made Accumulation in FY 2012-13 of Rs. 50,00,000 for spending it by the end of FY 2017-18. The Trust / Trustees have not been able to spend this money resulting in the said amount being subjected to tax the immediately following year i.e. FY 2018-19.

Current Liabilities

- 10 Current Liabilities include Rs. 43,39,008.89/- collected from members in respect of a legal proceedings undertaken by the Trust on behalf of the members. The said amount is disclosed as a liability till the settlement of the case or till such time the outcome is determined.

Corpus Donation

- 11 Written Directions from the Donors donations taken as corpus donation.

Special Matter, if any

- 12 So far as it is ascertainable from the books of accounts and according to the information and explanation given to us by the Treasurer, there were no special matters which are required to be brought to the notice of the Deputy Charity Commissioner.


